NOTES FOR WALKERS.

- 1 Wear stout boots/walking shoes.
- 2 Bring a waterproof jacket - over-trousers are also recommended. For your safety, the leader may ask you not to walk with the group if you are not adequately clothed.
- 3 Carry spare clothes, including hats, gloves and sunscreen.
- 4 Walkers are advised to seek advice about boots / clothing from a specialist outdoor shop.
- 5 Take sufficient food and drink on all walks.
- 6 Dogs must be on a lead of not more than 2m. At all times.
- 7 Please do not walk in front of the leader – for communication purposes.
- 8 Walkers are advised to carry a First Aid Kit

TRC is affiliated to the Ramblers Association and the group insurance with the RA is for public liability cover, not for personal accident cover.

The annual subscription runs from beginning of November. However, joining in September and October will carry your membership through to the following year. Prospective members are expected to apply for membership from the Treasurer, after completing 3 club walks.
